The **College of Education** at Lehigh University offers graduate programs in counseling, school psychology, educational technology, social-emotional learning, special education, and educational leadership. The college specializes in bringing research to practice for educators globally. Our research and courses combine domestic concerns in education and counseling with international discourse. The **Global Distance Programs** have offered international teachers, counselors, and school leaders graduate education since 2001. Through the Global Distance programs, the college has built connections with partner institutions across the globe.

The **Summer Institute** offers global students the opportunity to engage with professors and fellow students in an in-person intensive learning environment. The Summer Institute runs from late-June through the middle of July every year. In-person courses are offered in a condensed schedule over 5-9 days. Courses have been taught in-person in Bethlehem Pennsylvania, Athens Greece, and other international locations.

The College of Education is interested in **partnering with a new university in Greece** to offer the Summer Institute. We would like to partner with a university that has strong education and applied psychology programs.
