

Coaching for SOWL: Coaching Training for Global Education Professionals

Guanajuato, Mexico I May 11-17, 2025

Coaching for SELF-OTHER-WORLD LEARNING

(SOWL, pronounced "soul") is a short, immersive training experience **specifically designed for global education professionals interested in coaching.** If you are:

- curious about how to incorporate coaching modalities + perspectives into your work;
- desire a difference-attuned training that will work within culturally complex settings and with our particular stakeholder groups; and
- wish to develop deeper self-awareness in your own practice as a global educator;

then this is for you.

The curriculum starts and ends with practice. It is focused across the 3 dimensions of self, others and the world: in other words, how you show up, how you interact with and impact others, and how you engage with place + the larger contexts of global education work.

Together with your colleagues, you will:

- uncover more awareness about who you are as a global educator, learner and immerser;
- add nuance and depth to your intercultural skills;
- practice coaching individuals and small groups;
- consider some of our usual global education concepts from a new angle;
- integrate learning with applications in your specific arena (institution, program, learner group, design + facilitation, etc.); and
- emerge renewed and relaxed

This weeklong experience in Guanajuato, Mexico is focused on learning and practicing coaching techniques.

We will explore how a coachingbased perspective can inform global learning design and facilitation.

Outcomes

You will leave with

- greater self-awareness and clarity about who you are as an immersive learner, facilitator or designer of global learning endeavors
- the capacity to confidently hold coaching(esque) conversations with students, direct reports, and others
- fine-tuned and more subtle listening abilities
- knowledge of where/how to apply coaching as a pedagogical mode
- new ways of deeply connecting with global education stakeholders with empathy, curiosity and confidence
- renewed hope about global education's potential to contribute to a better world
- a plan for what's next for you personally
- an applied plan for a next step at work

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As part of this work, we will engage with place. Guanajuato is small, welcoming, and easy to move around in. You may find yourself meandering the twisty downtown to practice the perspectiveshifting work we will take on, bringing individual + cultural questions together as you engage with people, or maybe having a leisurely conversation about what mattes to you as a global educator with a colleague at a shady café.

We will spend the mornings doing the more indoor work; after the late lunch, the afternoons are fluid with individual conversations and some time to immerse.

Costs and what's included

Coaching for SOWL costs \$3,500. This includes:

- Hotel (single room) for the week (Sunday night through Saturday morning)
- Airport transfers to hotel and back (private transportation will be provided)
- Most meals
- Materials and any related group activities
